1. Economics (77.98%): Very good performance, indicating a good understanding of economic concepts.

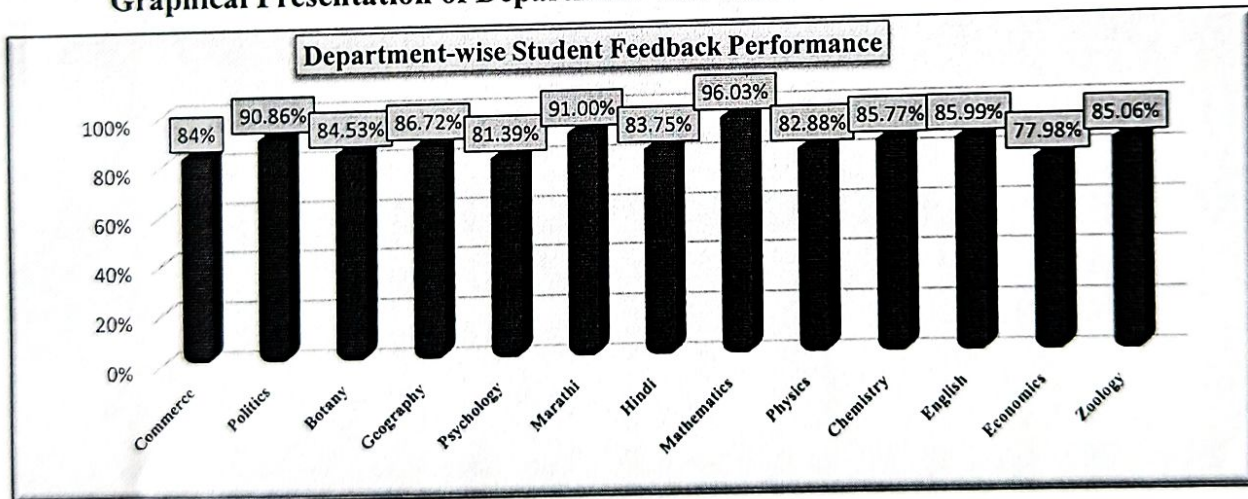
**Important Findings:**

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## Action Taken Report on students Feedback

### Academic Year-2023-2024

Feedback Committee collected online student's feedback during the academic year-2023-2024. The Feedback Responses have been collected in Google form. The meeting of the Action Taken Report was held on 25/04/2024 at 11.00 am in the conference hall beside the principal's cabin. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss on student feedbacks and prepared action taken report based on the student feedback responses collected through online mode (Google link). In the meeting action taken report is prepared by taking into account student's suggestions, observations regarding teaching learning mechanism of the college.

The student's opinions have been collected on the following points and prepared reports.

- a) Course Content/ Syllabus
- b) Course command
- c) Time management
- d) Teaching Aids/Methods and Pedagogy
- e) Laboratory Interface
- f) Helping Approach of teacher
- g) Evaluation Process

The above points discussed in the meeting and prepared action taken report based on Student feedback analysis report. Principal, a chairperson of the meeting, IQAC Coordinator and NAAC Coordinator commented on feedback analysis report. Principal appreciated to teacher for their classroom teaching performance. The analysis reports indicated that the majority of students have been rated teaching performance of their teacher as excellent or very good. But committee also took into account some suggestions that are needed for effective implementation of teaching learning mechanism.

The following suggestions and observation have been received from students.

1. The orientation of the students at the beginning of academic year.

2. Use of ICT tools for effective teaching- learning.
3. Skill based courses should be started.
4. Regular Assessment in the class.

The committee discussed student's suggestion in the meeting. Following suggestion has given to faculty members.

1. The teachers of the concerned subjects take orientation at the beginning of the academic year which would help students to clarify the course goals and expectations.
2. To make teaching learning effective, college gave emphasis on using technology like ICT, PPT, video lectures etc. The faculties have been started to prepare E-content to make teaching attractive and more comprehensive. Principal suggested the departments to begin skill-based courses from next academic year.
3. Head of the institute suggested to start new skill-based courses according to student requirement.
4. Head of the institute suggest all the faculties to conduct regular assessment of the students on the topic taught in the class.

10. Campus Placement Opportunities (79.7%): Alumni's appreciate the campus placement opportunities provided by the college.

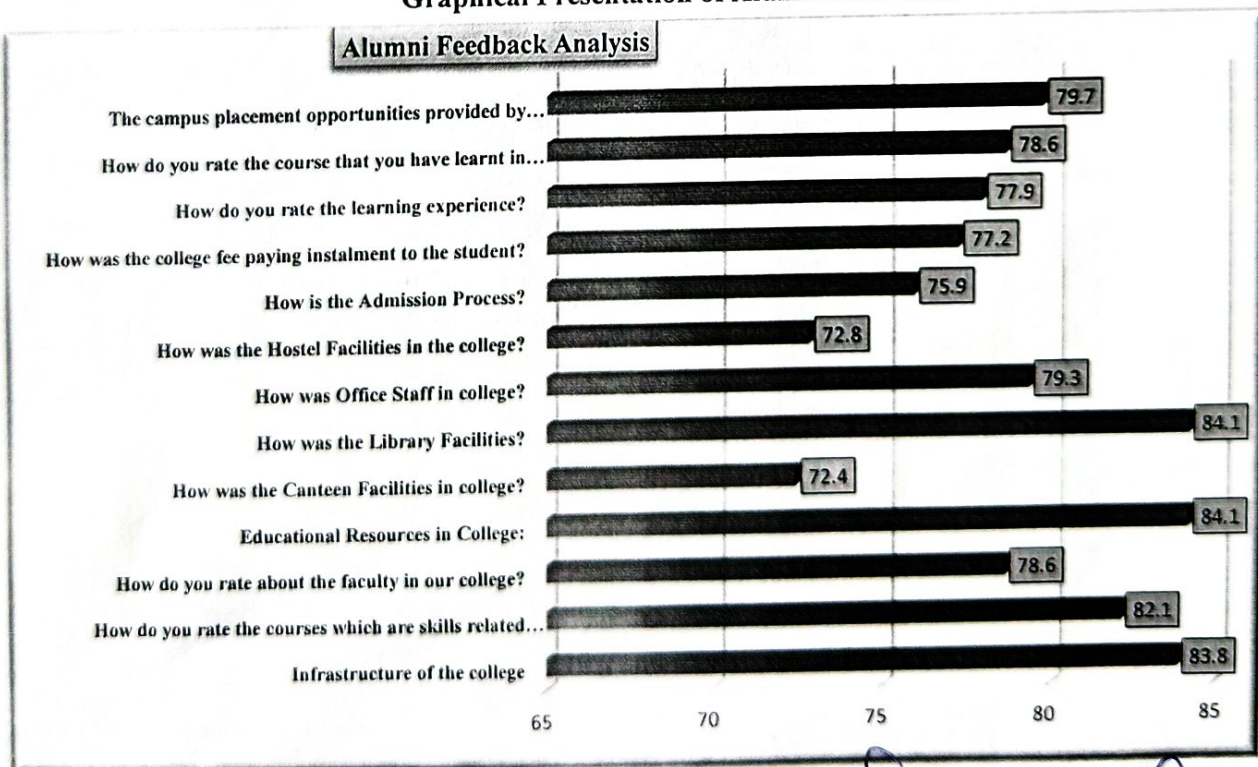
### Important Findings:

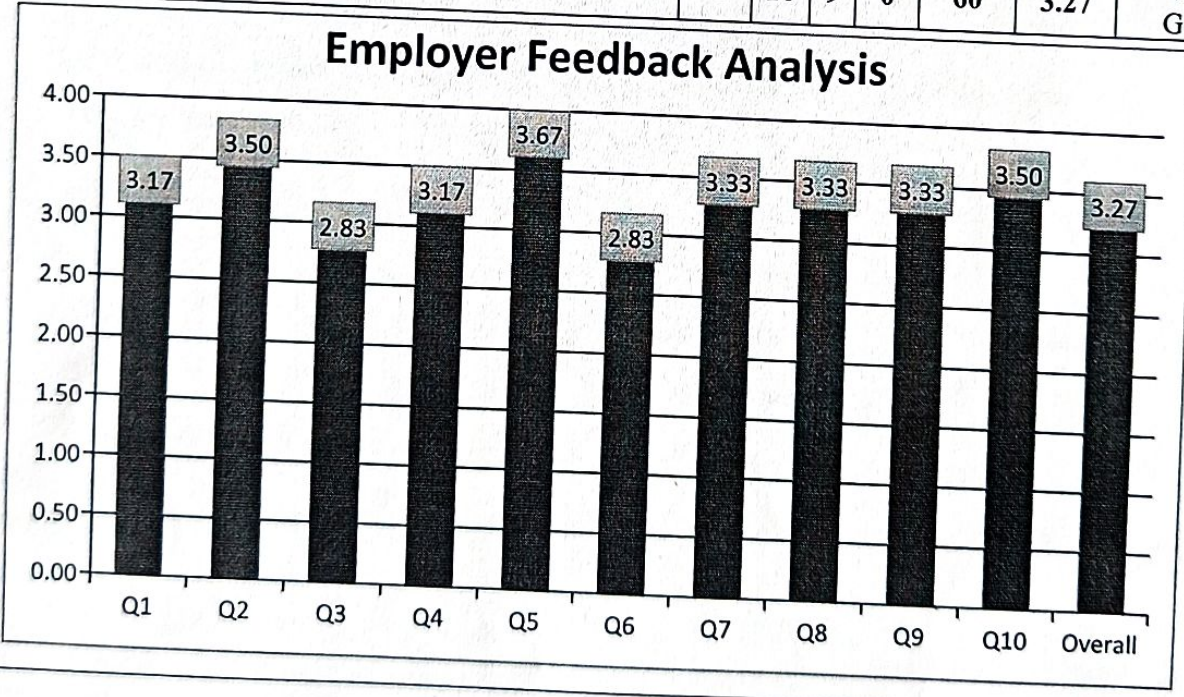

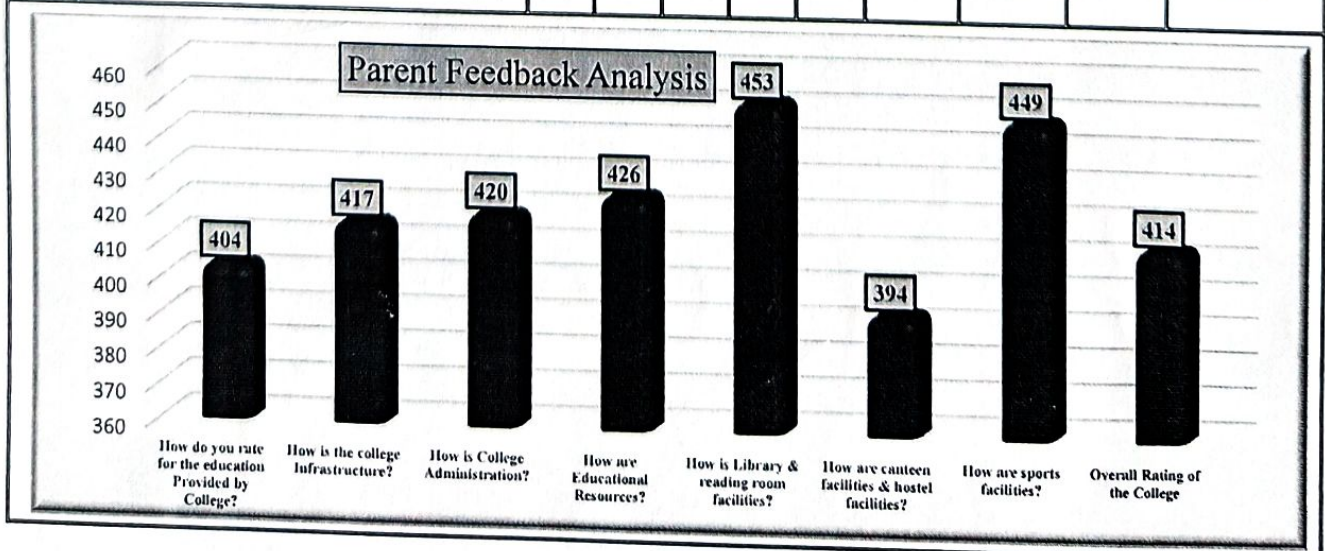

5. Maintain discipline and cleanliness standards, Continue administrative reforms and infrastructure development, Ensure consistent water facility quality and Encourage parent feedback for continuous improvement.

**Participation in Student-Parent Association:**

1. Only 24 parents (25.5%) were members of the Student-Parent Association and 70 parents (74.5%) were not members.

**Q.9:** 1.Sports Facility 29 (30.85%): Parents appreciate the college's sports facilities, indicating a well-equipped infrastructure for physical education.

2. Practical Lab and Infrastructure 55 (58.51%): The majority of parents praise the college's practical labs and infrastructure, suggesting that hands-on learning experiences are valued.

3. Reading Room and Library 66 (70.21%): Parents highly appreciate the college's reading room and library facilities, indicating a strong support system for academic research and learning.

4. All Teaching Staff is Supportive 22 (23.40%): Parents acknowledge the supportive nature of the teaching staff, highlighting the college's focus on student well-being.

5. Extra-Curricular 19 (20.21%): Parents appreciate the college's extra-curricular activities, suggesting a holistic approach to education.


**Q10.** 57.64% (49) parents feel that the student's development activities organized by the college have a good impact on the lives of the students while 24.70% (21) parents feel that it has a very good impact on student's life.

**Q.12.** the parents suggestions have been received on water facilities, Infrastructure Facility, disciplines, administrative reform and cleanness respectively.

1. Water Facilities (5, 8.2%): Some parents appreciate the college's water facilities.
2. Discipline (18, 29.5%): Many parents value the college's emphasis on discipline.
3. Administrative Reforms (12, 19.7%): Parents appreciate efforts to improve administrative processes.
4. Cleanliness (15, 24.6%): Parents praise the college's cleanliness and hygiene.
