#### Pune District Education Association :

The trust was established in the year 1941, before Independence by Late Shri. Baburaoji Gholap with philosophy of eradicating illiteracy in rural areas of Pune District thereby bringing about social upliftment of the masses. The mission of the Trust is '**Bahujan Hitay Bahujan Sukhay**' and this is being accomplished by providing quality education to all. The Trust has successfully completed 81 year. The efforts of the trust have been recognized by the government and Society and it was declared as the "Best Educational Institution" by Government of Maharashtra in year 2000.

As it stands today the Trust has emerged into a network of the institutions providing education from Preprimary to Post Graduate and Ph.D. levels. The trust is lead by Hon. Ex. Deputy CM **Mr. Ajitdada Pawar** who through his dynamic abilities and vision has brought a facelift in the infrastructural facilities of the Schools and Colleges of the Trust. Since the world has become a global village, the vision of the Trust has been extended and the Trust is foraying into the national and global arena.

#### About the College :

Pune District Education Association's Annasaheb Waghire Arts, Science and Commerce College, Otur was established in 1970 with the efforts of Late. Shri. Baburaoji Gholap founder of the parent institution. It is the first science college of the institution in the Pune District located in the rural and hilly area under the jurisdiction of grampanchayat, Otur.

Otur is situated on the banks of Mandavi river which flows from the east along the Sant Babaji Chaitanya Maharaj Samadhi Mandir (who is the Guru of the Jagatguru Sant Shri Tukaram Maharaj) and "Kapardikeshwar Mahadev temple". Otur

has a great historical, cultural, social and spiritual heritage. The Great King "Chhatrapati Shri Shivaji Maharaj" was born in the hill-fort of "Shivneri", near the city of Junnar in Pune district which is around 20 km away from Otur.

The college has completed 53 years by making remarkable progress in the higher education. The college is well accessible, situated 105 kilometers from Pune, near Mumbai-Vishakhapatnam (Via Ahmednagar) National Highway (NH-61) and just 12 kilometers from Pune-Nashik National Highway (NH-60). The College campus admeasures 24 acres and has well-furnished infrastructure for academic and administrative purposes. The College runs UG and PG Programs under the faculty of Arts, Commerce and Science.

#### About the Seminar

With the changes and reforms in the global education scenario, the Indian government has proposed constructive changes in the education system to overlay the way for building a strong and progressive nation. The National Education Policy 2020 which was released on July 29, 2020, emphasizes the new policies at all levels of education.

The policy has projected the holistic development of youth with prominence on improvement in Gross Enrolment Ratio, GER in addition to skill development as the determining factor to increase the employability and entrepreneurship. The inclusion of skill component from early school education will help to make self-reliant India. At the undergraduate level, inclusion of multidisciplinary approach and vocational courses will be fundamental in producing skilled graduates in tune with industrial revolution 4.0. The NEP 2020 provides that even the students of middle level shall be exposed to hands-on training in vocational skills like carpentry, plumbing, electrical repairing, horticulture, pottery, embroidery, etc. The policy has set the target of providing vocational skills to at least 50% students by 2025 in such a way that the vocational skills acquired at school level may be further extended up to higher education level, depending upon the requirement of individual students.

The National skill development initiatives for youth in health, pharma, agriculture, electronics and other emerging areas will prove to be a significant benchmark and is linked with the theme of 'vocal for local', which enables the aspiring youth to find employment opportunities in local areas. So the day is not far when the Indian youth will not be a job-seeker but a potential job-giver through the set of personality, vocational, employable and entrepreneurial skills imparted to them at different stages of

education and training proposed in the NEP 2020.
